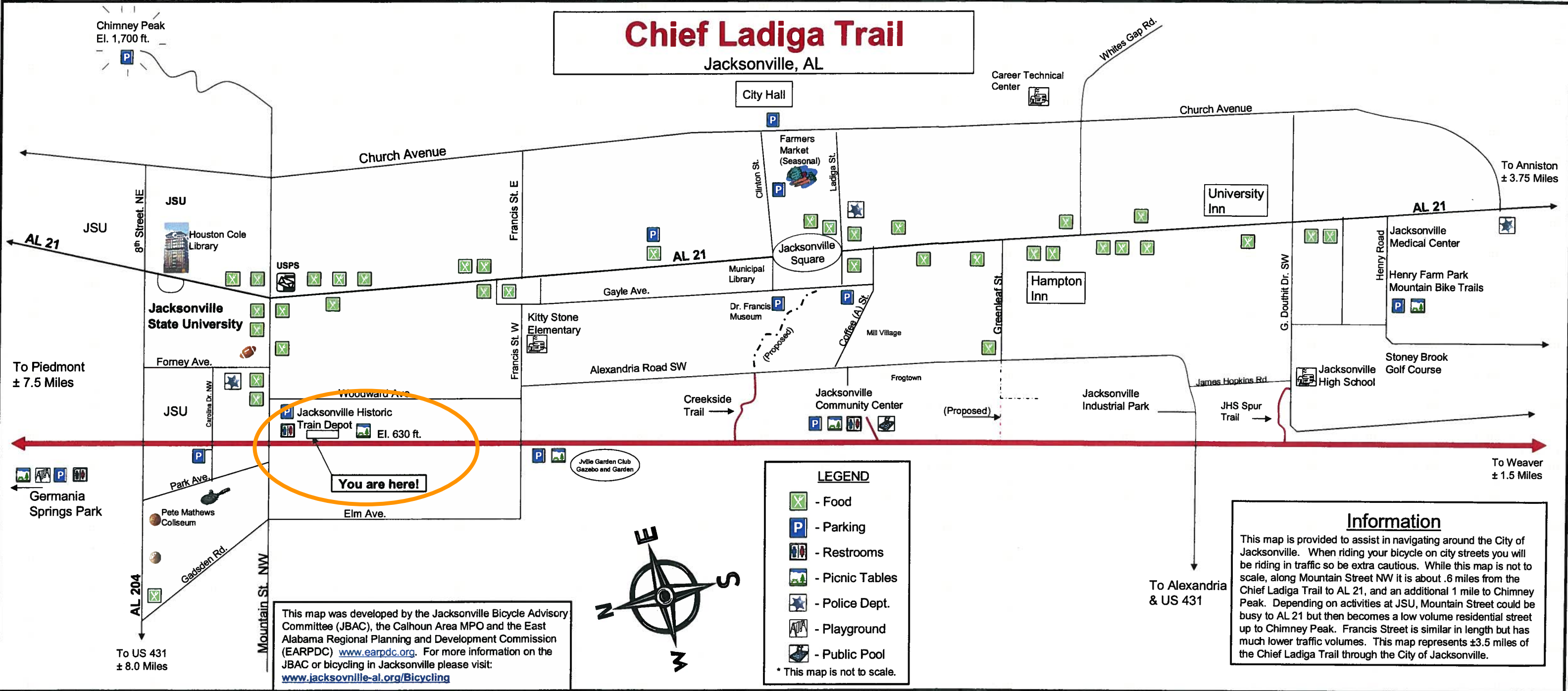


Chief Ladiga Trail

Information

This map is provided to assist in navigating around the City of Jacksonville. When riding your bicycle on city streets you will be riding in traffic so be extra cautious. While this map is not to scale, along Mountain Street NW it is about .6 miles from the Chief Ladiga Trail to AL 21, and an additional 1 mile to Chimney Peak. Depending on activities at JSU, Mountain Street could be busy to AL 21 but then becomes a low volume residential street up to Chimney Peak. Francis Street is similar in length but has much lower traffic volumes. This map represents ±3.5 miles of the Chief Ladiga Trail through the City of Jacksonville.
